A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in Risk Management, Safety Management, Public Administration, Financial Management, Business Administration or a closely related field; and seven years of progressively responsible experience which includes at least three years at the management or supervisory level and includes administrative responsibility for the development and maintenance of risk management, Workers' Compensation loss control, casualty insurance, emergency response and safety engineering programs in a public agency; or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Designation of Associate in Risk Manager (ARM), Certified Safety Professional (CSP), Certified Industrial Hygienist (CIH), or Professional Safety Engineer (PSE) is desirable.
