The General Manager of the Heber Public Utility District (HPUD) will have the opportunity to work for a growing district that provides water, sewer, parks and solid waste services to approximately 6,600 people. The General Manager works closely with the five-member elected Board of Directors and will inherit an excellent, stable workforce of talented and dedicated professionals.

The position requires a broad range of professional abilities and understanding in all areas of government functions, with an emphasis on strong leadership and a commitment to support Heber's future success and potential growth. The community of Heber is located in Imperial County between two of the largest cities (El Centro and Calexico) along the highways 86 and 111 corridors, and minutes from the border with Mexico.

The HPUD Board is looking for a professional administrator that has the ability to cultivate strong working relationships with stakeholders, and who will continue a good working environment based upon trust, mutual respect and cooperation. The ideal candidate will have knowledge and experience in managing a complex organization in an environment with high expectations. A combination of training and experience that provides required knowledge, skills and abilities may be qualifying. In general, required qualifications are: A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in environmental science, management, engineering or other field related to the work; AND At least five years of appropriate management experience with a variety of complex issues, negotiating and monitoring contracts as well as developing staff and overseeing capital improvement projects. Managerial experience in a city, water agency or special district is desirable.

The District offers a competitive benefits package, including California Public Employees Retirement System pension, and medical, dental, and vision. In addition, benefits are provided which currently includes vacation, personal leave, holidays, and other types of leave.
