Any combination of training and experience that would provide the required knowledge, skills and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the required qualifications would be: Education: Equivalent to a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major coursework in public administration, urban planning, economics, business administration, or a related field. Experience: Six (6) years of increasingly responsible professional experience in housing administration, community development, or a related field, of which three (3) years should be in a lead or supervisory capacity. Licenses and Certifications: Possession of a valid California Driver's License, to be maintained throughout employment.
