The Construction Manager/Facilities Program Manager is a leadership and managerial position in the Public Works Department and will oversee the development and implementation of facilities capital projects. The City owns and maintains over 53 facilities, including the Administration Building (Airport), Public Works, Police Department, Fire Department, Development Services, Facilities Admin Building, Fleet Division Shop, Parks and Recreational Facilities, and Streets/Snow Operations Corporation Yard. The City is currently undergoing implementation of several exciting and large-scale projects, including a new \$68 million Recreation and Aquatic Center. The Construction Manager/Facilities Program Manager will oversee the construction and delivery of this project for the next two years. In addition, the City is conducting a feasibility Study for a new \$12 million Design-Build Fire Station.

The City has recently completed a Conditions Assessment for all facilities. The City has also released a Design-Build RFP for Energy Upgrades for City Facilities. The Construction Manager/Facilities Program Manager will collaborate with the Sustainability Coordinator to implement Design-Build for Energy and EV projects throughout the City. The City is evaluating the organizational structure so that the Construction Manager/Facilities Program Manager will oversee the Facilities Maintenance Division, plus an Associate Civil/Architectural Engineer, which is programmed for approval by the City Council in 2023).

This managerial and leadership position requires substantial experience in construction management, especially in facilities. A bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering, Construction Management, Architectural Engineering, or a related degree is required. In addition, a minimum of six years of Construction Management, Project Management, and other related experience is required. Registration as a Professional Civil Engineer or Architecture is highly desired, or the ability to obtain one within two years of employment. A California Drivers License or ability to obtain one is required.
