Duties include performing complex financial analysis; developing financial models, plans, and forecasts; preparing financial reporting templates and management dashboards; documenting budget processes and procedures; and leading process improvements within the Budgets and Financial Planning & Analysis Section.

An appropriate combination of education and experience that has provided the required knowledge, skills and abilities is qualifying. A typical way of obtaining the required qualifications is: A Bachelor's degree in accounting, finance, public or business administration, or a related field, including a minimum of 24 semester-hours in accounting (a Master's degree is highly desirable). Seven years of increasingly complex and diverse professional accounting work experience, two years of which having full supervisory responsibility for two or more major accounting functions, including the equivalent of two years as an Accountant/Auditor III for MTC.
