Under the general direction of a Division Chief, the Fire Captain is responsible for planning, implementing, supervising and directing programs and projects at the company level; organizes and oversees day-to-day company activities, including responding to routine and emergency calls, the maintenance of an assigned station, apparatus, and equipment, and the generation of required reports and logs; maintains personnel availability coverage; responds to emergencies and directs emergency operations until relieved by a senior officer; ensures adherence to all Department and Operational policies, procedures, and protocols and disseminates Department information to the company; and performs other duties as required and special projects as assigned.

Education: Equivalent to graduation from high school; and successful completion of all courses of the California State Board of Fire Services Fire Officer series. An Associate of Science degree in Fire Science is highly desirable. Experience: Four (4) years of full-time firefighting experience in the position of Firefighter or above within the City of Patterson, or a multi-company fire service agency, that includes at least two (2) years of experience as a Fire Engineer. License or Certificate: Possession of a valid California driver's license in compliance with California Department of Motor Vehicles regulations and requirements related to driving and operating fire apparatus. Maintenance of a valid California driver's license with the appropriate endorsements, qualifications, and medical clearances is required as a condition of employment for the position of Fire Captain. Certification(s): Possession of an EMT certification; a BLS CPR certification; and California State Board of Fire Services Firefighter I and Firefighter II certifications.
