The City of Placerville, historically known as "Old Hangtown," has a rich Gold Rush history. It lies in the heart of the Sierra Foothills, 35 minutes east of the state capitol of Sacramento and one hour west of the world-class resort destination of Lake Tahoe. The historic downtown reflects a respect for the history of the community and pride of having been originally incorporated in 1854, only five years after the start of the Gold Rush. The area surrounding the City is abundant with apple orchards, Christmas tree farms, and wineries. The position: Under the general direction of the City Engineer, supervises and coordinates the daily wastewater operations, maintenance and repair activities of the City's Water Reclamation Facility and collection activities; ensures work quality and adherence to established policies and procedures; coordinates assigned activities with other divisions, outside agencies, and the general public; and provides highly responsible and complex staff assistance to the City Engineer.

Education/Training: Equivalent to the completion of the twelfth grade supplemented by specialized training in Water Reclamation Facility operations and/or maintenance. Some college or related coursework is preferred. Experience: Four years of responsible experience relative to the operation and maintenance of a wastewater treatment facility including one year of administrative and/or lead supervisory experience. License or Certificate: Possession of, or ability to obtain by date of appointment, an appropriate California driver's license. Possession of a California Water Reclamation Facility Operator Grade IV certificate issued by the State Water Resource Control Board or higher.
