Position: The Fire Marshal is a civilian, non-safety, at-will, management position which organizes, directs, coordinates and supervises all Heartland Fire & Rescue activities involving the Fire Prevention Division. This includes difficult and complex inspections of industrial and residential properties and places of assembly; coordinates and performs plan examinations, inspections, and enforcement for fire protection systems within State/Federal fire codes and regulations. The ideal candidate will have the ability to manage and lead a prevention division across multiple jurisdictions (City of El Cajon, City of La Mesa, and City of Lemon Grove).

The ideal candidate will have at least five (5) years of fire protection or prevention experience; OR, five (5) years of related work requiring the application and/or enforcement of fire, building or construction codes; OR, five (5) years of experience examining building or fire sprinkler plans or inspecting buildings or fire sprinkler systems; OR five (5) years of any combination of fire or building inspection work experience as stated above. The above experience should include two (2) years of progressively responsible experience in the areas of fire and life safety supervision and management.
