The Associate/Senior Engineer position is a management level position reporting to the District Engineer. The position is responsible

for engineering functions including, but not limited to, land development, water resources, planning, capital improvement projects (CIPs), customer service, budgets, and various day-to-day tasks. The position assists the District Engineer in the development, implementation, and evaluation of shortand long-term engineering goals and objectives to achieve the District's mission, strategic plan, and Board priorities. The position will work towards the development and prioritization to ensure the projects meet the objectives and goals set by the District Engineer, General Manager, and Board of Directors. This position requires strong project and construction management skills. Must be able to effectively manage multiple disciplines, meet deadlines, and make sound decisions. Camrosa is currently developing a Master Plan that will include infrastructure priorities as well as new local water CIPs to enhance our water portfolio and reduce our dependence on import water. Potential projects include groundwater recharge, RO plant(s), new wells, and expansion of non-potable/recycle water. This is an opportunity to develop a new level of expertise in a wide range of areas.
