A typical way to obtain the required qualifications would be: Equivalent to graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major coursework in accounting, finance, business or public administration, or a closely related field and five (5) years of responsible professional accounting experience, including experience in grants accounting for state and federally funded projects.
