Under general direction, plans, organizes, oversees, coordinates, and manages the staff and operations of the Building and Safety Division; areas of responsibility include building inspection, plans examination, and permit processing; manages the effective use of the division's resources to improve organizational productivity and customer service; provides highly complex and responsible support to the Development Services Director in areas of expertise; and performs related work as required.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE Any combination of training and experience that would provide the required knowledge, skills, and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the required qualifications would be: Equivalent to a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major coursework in planning, engineering, public administration, business administration, or a related field and Five (5) years of increasingly responsible management and/or administrative experience within a building and safety program, two (2) of which should be in a management capacity LICENSES AND CERTIFICATIONS Possession of or ability to obtain and maintain a valid California Driver's License Certification as a Combination Building Inspector, Plans Examiner, or other special training in the Building, Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing trades through the International Conference of Building Officials (ICBO) or an equivalent professional association Certification as a Building Official from the International Code Council (ICC)
