FIREFIGHTER EMT

Firefighter: EMT \$65,588 - \$87,894 Annually

This safety position will respond to fire alarms, emergency medical calls, traffic accidents, rescue and other emergency calls to protect life and property. This position will also participate in trainings, drills, study activities and in the maintenance of the department apparatus, equipment and facilities. Under the supervision of the Fire Engineer or Fire Captain, provides first responder basic life support (EMT) or performs ALS (paramedic) care to patients of medical emergencies and other medical procedures. Performs other duties as required. The ideal candidate in this classification must exhibit composure and good situational awareness on emergency scenes to effectively respond to, support, and communicate with crews. An individual in this classification must also work effectively as part of a unit during emergencies, represent the Department professionally at public service/education events, and interact cooperatively with other City personnel and allied agencies.

This recruitment is open until filled. Applications will be reviewed periodically when a sufficient number of applications have been received. The first review of applications will be on June 30, 2025.

Education: Possession of a high school diploma or GED. License or Certificate: Possession of a current California Driver's License, Class C. Valid National Registry EMT-P or EMT Certification or California Paramedic or EMT License. Must also have certification in CPR, Basic Life Support (BLS), Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS), Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) and trauma (BTLS or PHTLS) by time of appointment. Hazardous Materials, First Responder Operations (FRO) Certified ICS 200 certification.

Firefighter 1 certification (California State Fire Training), or graduation from a California State Fire Marshal's accredited Firefighter I Academy, or possess 12 college credits from a Regionally Accredited Fire Technology/Fire Science college or university level program and successfully complete the Firefighter Academy once hired. Current CPAT certification (within past 12 months). Must be current on the Firefighter Candidate Testing Center (FCTC) list with a score of at least 70%.
